

Thank you for the invitation to appear before the Senate Committee on Health, Children, Families, Aging and Long Term Care next week to discuss my nomination as a member of the Board of Trustees of the Medical College of Wisconsin. Sufficient public notice should be given in any case to allow members of the public who wish to testify on the appointment to do so.

Please be advised that committees historically have not voted on appointments of the Governor unless a statement of economic interest is on file. For nominees who were previously nominated but not confirmed by the Senate, the statement should already be on file. For new nominees, you should receive the statement of economic interest before having a public hearing and taking executive action.
