SENATE FLOOR DEBATE
February ~~3~~⁴ 2004

UNDER CURRENT LAW, A LICENSED DENTAL HYGIENIST IS NOT
REQUIRED TO OBTAIN CONTINUING EDUCATION AS A
CONDITION FOR LICENSE RENEWAL. A HYGIENIST ONLY HAS
TO PAY A ~~\$40~~^{\$25} RENEWAL FEE AND THEIR STATE LICENSE IS
AUTOMATICALLY RENEWED.

ON BEHALF OF THE WISCONSIN DENTAL HYGIENISTS
ASSOCIATION, I INTRODUCED SB 225, WHICH REQUIRES DENTAL
HYGIENISTS TO COMPLY WITH CONTINUING EDUCATION
REQUIREMENTS AS A CONDITION FOR LICENSE RENEWAL.
ACCORDING TO THE DENTAL HYGIENISTS ASSOCIATION, A
RECENT SURVEY INDICATED THAT 84% OF WISCONSIN
HYGIENISTS WHO RESPONDED AGREED THAT CONTINUING
EDUCATION FOR LICENSE RENEWAL SHOULD BE MANDATED
BY THE STATE, AND HAVE WANTED A MANDATE FOR TWO
DECADES.

WISCONSIN IS ONE OF ONLY THREE STATES THAT DO NOT REQUIRE CONTINUING EDUCATION FOR DENTAL HYGIENE LICENSE RENEWAL. THE OTHER STATES ARE COLORADO AND WYOMING. BOTH ARE CURRENTLY SEEKING MANDATORY CONTINUING EDUCATION AS WELL.

AFTER LISTENING TO CONCERNS RAISED AT THE PUBLIC HEARING, THE SENATE HEALTH COMMITTEE PASSED SENATE AMENDMENT 1.

THE AMENDMENT DOES THE FOLLOWING:

- INCREASES THE RENEWAL FEE 17% FROM \$57 EVERY 2 YEARS TO \$69 EVERY 2 YEARS. THE 17% INCREASE MUST BE USED FOR THE PURPOSE OF DETERMINING THE COMPLIANCE OF RENEWAL APPLICANTS. THIS IS LOW COMPARED TO THE FEES REQUIRED IN NEIGHBORING STATES:

*ILLINOIS: \$50 A YEAR.

*MINNESOTA: \$50 A YEAR.

- CHANGES THE REQUIREMENT THAT A PERSON MUST HAVE “TAUGHT, ATTENDED OR OTHERWISE COMPLETED” 20 HOURS OF C.E. AS A CONDITION OF HAVING THEIR LICENSE RENEWED. “TAUGHT” IS CHANGED TO “PREPARED.”
- REQUIRES THAT THE C.E. COURSES BE RELATED TO THE PRACTICE OF DENTAL HYGIENE AND BE SPONSORED OR RECOGNIZED BY A LOCAL, STATE, REGIONAL, NATIONAL OR INTERNATIONAL DENTAL, DENTAL HYGIENE, DENTAL ASSISTING, OR MEDICAL-RELATED PROFESSIONAL ORGANIZATION.
- REMOVES THE LIMIT ON THE NUMBER OF CREDIT HOURS THAT CAN BE SATISFIED BY SELF-STUDY, CORRESPONDENCE OR INTERNET PROGRAMS OR COURSES.
- INCREASES THE NUMBER OF VOLUNTEER HOURS THAT CAN BE USED AS C.E. TO 8 HOURS, UP FROM 5.

- INDICATES THAT ONE CREDIT HOUR OF VOLUNTARY ACTIVITIES IS EQUIVALENT TO ONE CREDIT HOUR OF CONTINUING EDUCATION. *DH access*
- ALLOWS A PERSON TO SUBSTITUTE CREDIT HOURS OF COLLEGE LEVEL COURSES RELATED TO THE PRACTICE OF DENTAL HYGIENE FOR THE C.E. 1 CREDIT HOUR OF A COLLEGE LEVEL COURSE IS EQUIVALENT TO 6 CREDIT HOURS OF CONTINUING EDUCATION.
- CLARIFIES THAT A PERSON WHO TEACHES A CONTINUING EDUCATION PROGRAM MORE THAN ONCE DURING A 2 YEAR PERIOD MAY USE THAT PROGRAM ONLY ONCE DURING THAT 2 YEAR PERIOD TO SATISFY THE C.E. REQUIREMENT.

AGAIN, THE DENTAL HYGIENISTS IN THIS STATE HAVE ASKED FOR THIS CONTINUING EDUCATION REQUIREMENT. THEY BELIEVE THAT PATIENT SAFETY IS AFFECTED WHEN LICENSE HOLDERS ARE NOT HELD ACCOUNTABLE OR GIVEN PRECISE REQUIREMENTS FOR MAINTAINING THEIR LICENSE.

PATIENTS SHOULD BE ABLE TO TRUST THAT A PROFESSIONAL WHO IS LICENSED BY THE STATE HAS MET REASONABLE REQUIREMENTS FOR CONTINUING EDUCATION. WITHOUT IT, PATIENT TRUST AND SAFETY MAY BE COMPROMISED.

I HOPE THAT YOU WILL SUPPORT THIS BILL TODAY.



**The Department of Regulation and Licensing does not like the following:*

- One volunteer hour equals one continuing education (C.E.) credit.
- An organization relating to "dental assisting" may sponsor C.E. courses.

LRB 2012 does the following:

- Increases the renewal fee 17% from \$57 every two years to \$69. The 17% increase must be used for the purpose of determining the compliance of renewal applicants.
- Changes the requirement that a person must have "taught, attended or otherwise completed" 20 hours of C.E. as a condition of having their license renewed. "Taught" is changed to "prepared."
- Requires that the C.E. courses be related to the practice of dental hygiene and be sponsored or recognized by a local, state, regional, national or international dental, dental hygiene, dental assisting, or medical-related professional organization.
- Removes the limit on the number of credit hours that can be satisfied by self-study, correspondence or Internet programs or courses.
- Increases the number of volunteer hours that can be used as C.E. to 8 hours, up from 5.
- Indicates that one credit hour of voluntary activities is equivalent to one credit hour of continuing education.

- Allows a person to substitute credit hours of college level courses related to the practice of dental hygiene for the C.E. One credit hour of a college level course is equivalent to 6 credit hours of continuing education.
 - Clarifies that a person who teaches a continuing education program more than once during a 2 year period may use that program only once during that 2 year period to satisfy the C.E. requirement.

Jennifer, the only two things we see is first, the volunteer hours are still 1 for 1. It's pretty soft, not the end of the world, but soft.

Also, I noticed they put in 'dental assistants' as an approved course of study. Dental Assistants are not licensed by the state and are at a lower level then a hygienist. I can't imagine what a hygienist could learn of value from a dental assistant course.
