Under **current law**, certain highway routes and bridges have been designated and marked to memorialize, commemorate, or recognize certain individuals or events.

Senate Bill 40 directs the Department of Transportation to designate and, upon receipt of sufficient contributions from interested parties, mark the route of USH 14 in this state from the Wisconsin-Illinois border to **Richland Center, Wisconsin** as the “Ronald Reagan Highway” in recognition and appreciation of the public career of Ronald Reagan, 40th President of the United States.

Senate Amendment 1 substitutes “Madison” for “Richland Center” in the bill so that the Ronald Reagan Highway” would be from the Wisconsin-Illinois border to **Madison, Wisconsin**.

Legislative History

Senate Amendment 1, offered by Senator Schultz and others, was adopted by the Senate on a voice vote. **Senate Bill 40**, as amended by Senate Amendment 1, passed the Senate on a voice vote on May 6, 2003.

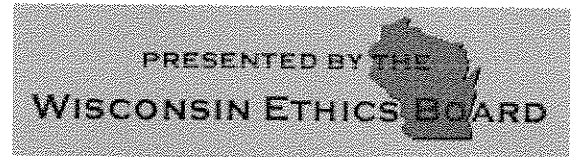
