Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This substitute amendment adopts, for state income and franchise tax purposes, section 1201 of Public Law 108–173 as it relates to claiming a deduction for an amount that a person pays into a health savings account, except that it only applies to individuals who have not had health insurance within the 12 months previous to their claim for the deduction that this substitute amendment allows, and to businesses that have not provided health insurance to their employees within the 12 months previous to their claim for the deduction that this substitute amendment allows.)

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **SECTION 1.** 71.83 (1) (ce) of the statutes is created to read:
