AB 15 Amendment Request - Ethanol Study Requirement

Rep. Nass is requesting that a substitute amendment to AB 15 be drafted to do the following:

- -Prevent the Department of Commerce from establishing any mandatory requirement on the level of ethanol that must be contained in automotive gasoline, prior to completion of a study itemized below and for a period of 12 months following submission of the study/findings to the legislature.
- -The ASA should also require that the Department of Natural Resources prepare, in consultation with the US Environmental Protection Agency, the California Air Resources Board, and industry fuel experts a study on ethanol.
- -The study shall report on the following:
- 1.) The air quality impacts of ethanol use in gasoline, including whether gasoline required in certain ozone nonattainment areas would have greater ozone benefits without ethanol;
- 2.) The energy consumption and environmental impacts with increased production of ethanol, including air quality, water quality, and solid waste impacts;
- 3.) Motor vehicle fuel efficiency impacts of ethanol in gasoline.
- -The study and its findings shall be submitted to the Legislature and reviewed by the standing committees with jurisdiction over natural resources and the environment. The DNR will have 24 months following the effective date of this act to submit the report to the legislature.



### ASSEMBLY SUBSTITUTE AMENDMENT,

#### TO 2005 ASSEMBLY BILL 15



1 AN ACT/...; relating to: ethanol requirements in automotive gasoline and a study of ethanol.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

**SECTION 1.** 168.04 (2m) of the statutes is created to read:

after the month in which the department receives the report under 2005 Wisconsin Act .... (this act), section , the department may not prescribe a specification that requires automotive gasoline to contain ethanol.

SECTION 2. Nonstatutory provisions.

(Y) ETHANOL STUDY.

(a) The department of natural resources shall conduct a study on ethanol, in conjunction with the federal environmental protection agency, the California air

- resources board, and fuel experts in private industry. The department shall study all of the following:
- 1. The effects of the use of ethanol in automotive gasoline on air quality, including whether using automotive gasoline without ethanol in an ozone nonattainment area designated under section 285.23 of the statutes would decrease the amount of ozone in the air, as compared to using automotive gasoline that contains ethanol.
- 2. The effects of increased production of ethanol on energy consumption and environmental quality, including effects on air quality, water quality, and solid waste management.
- 3. The effects of the use of ethanol in automotive gasoline on the fuel efficiency of automobiles.
- (b) No later than the first day of the 25th month beginning after the effective date of this paragraph, the department of natural resources shall submit a report on the study under paragraph (a), including its findings, to the standing committees of the legislature with jurisdiction over natural resources in the manner provided in section 13,172 (3) of the statutes, and to the department of commerce.
