**ASSEMBLY AMENDMENT ,
TO 2005 ASSEMBLY BILL 32**

1 At the locations indicated, amend the bill as follows:

2 **1.** Page 5, line 7: delete "456.04 (2m)" and substitute "456.04 (2m) and (3m)".

3 **2.** Page 5, line 9: delete lines 9 to 13 and substitute "as provided in s. 456.04
4 (2m) and (3m), the rules shall require the individual to provide evidence satisfactory
5 to the examining board that the individual has, in any consecutive 3-year period
6 within the 5-year period immediately preceding the date of application for
7 examination, obtained at least 2,000 hours of supervised practical experience that
8 substantially relates to the practice of a nursing home administrator, as determined
9 by the examining board.".

10 **3.** Page 5, line 16: delete "sub. (2m)" and substitute "subs. (2m) and (3m)".

11 **4.** Page 7, line 6: after that line insert:

12 "**SECTION 15m.** 456.04 (3m) of the statutes is created to read:

-2- all of the following apply:
P (a)

1 456.04 (3m) The examining board shall allow a person to take the examination
2 for licensure as a nursing home administrator if the person satisfies the
3 requirements specified in sub. (1m) (a), (b), and (c) and during the 5-year period
4 immediately preceding application, and without interruption or suspension, the
5 person has been licensed as a registered nurse under s. 441.06, or has been licensed
6 as a registered nurse in another state.

P (c) For 3 years during the 5-year period immediately preceding application, the person was employed in a position that substantially relates to the practice of a nursing home administrator, as determined by the examining board."
