- **1.** Page 3, line 14: delete lines 14 to 17 and substitute:
- "2. "Long-term care expenses" means all of the following:
 - a. Any amount that is paid for care that is provided to an individual in an individual's home or in institutional or community-based settings and that is convalescent or custodial care or care for a chronic condition or terminal illness.
 - b. Any amount that is paid by an individual for a long-term care insurance policy, as defined in s. 71.05 (6) (b) 26. a.".
 - **2.** Page 3, line 24: after "account." insert "If an individual uses amounts from an account for long–term care expenses to pay for a long–term care insurance policy, the individual may not claim the subtraction under s. 71.05 (6) (b) 26.".
