Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current laws requires each state agency to submit every six years a report that contains a description of each programmatic activity of the state agency and information relating to expenditures and revenue sources for each programmatic activity. This bill requires that once a state agency has used a certain format for its report, the state agency must use that format for all future reports.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

- **SECTION 1.** 16.423 (5) of the statutes is created to read:
- 4 16.423 **(5)** Notwithstanding sub. (4), once a state agency has used a certain
- 5 format for its report, the state agency shall use that format for all future reports
