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

3 "SECTION ^{4r}4m. 111.337 (2) ^(d)(c) of the statutes is created to read:

4 111.337 (2) ^(d)(c). To require an employee who is a physician or pharmacist, and
5 who refuses, or states an intention to refuse, based on the employee's creed, to
6 participate in an activity specified in sub. (1r) (b) 1. to 8., to post a notice described
7 under s. 448.03 (5) (au) or 450.135 (4)."

8 2. Page 6, line ⁶ 4: delete that line and substitute "or fetus. A- any of the
9 following:".

10 3. Page 6, line ⁷ 5: delete that line and substitute "(b) Except as provided in sub.
11 (4m), a physician or any other person who is a member of or associated with the".
