Technical Memorandum on 2005 AB 245 Concerning Utility Aid Payments Based

on the Megawatt Capacity of Wind Farms

We have the following concerns about the bill.

The change in the gross receipts utility tax would take effect on the day after publication. To aid in administration, and to prevent problems with any existing wind farms that could fall under the bill's provisions, we suggest that the effective date for this change be January 1, 2006.

The bill would also be effective for the utility aid provisions beginning with payments in July 2005. Municipalities and counties are notified of their utility shared revenue distributions for the coming year on September 15. Notices for the payments in 2005 have already been issued, and taxes levied, based on information in those estimates. We suggest that the effective date for the change in utility shared revenues be effective with the payments in July 2006.
