## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

This bill requires no new duties to be performed by the licensing body, it simply moves up the date after which the licensor may charge a late fee.

The department receives no information on when dog licenses are purchased or if they are purchased in a timely manner. This lack of data makes it impossible for a determination to be made on how many dog licenses may be eligible for a late fee that would not have been under current law.
