Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The bill may reduce local governmental costs for public improvements if local governments adopt subdivision ordinances for extra territorial areas that require a subdivider to make or provide a bond or other security for public improvements that otherwise would fall to the municipality. It is unknown how many municipalities may undertake such ordinances or the value of the public improvements such ordinances may require.
