1 79.10 (9) (bc) *Disabled veterans tax credit*. Except as provided in ss. 79.175 and
2 79.18, every property taxpayer who applies and is eligible for a credit under sub.
3 (10m) shall receive the credit in the amount determined under sub. (10m).

4 SECTION 7. 79.10 (9) (c) 2. of the statutes is amended to read:

5 79.10 (9) (c) 2. The credit credits under par. pars. (b) and (bc) shall reduce the
6 property taxes otherwise payable.

7 SECTION 8. 79.10 (10m) of the statutes is created to read:

8 79.10 (10m) DISABLED VETERANS TAX CREDIT. (a) In this subsection, "disabled
9 veteran" means a veteran who receives 100 percent disability compensation from the
10 U.S. department of veterans affairs under 38 USC 1114 because of a permanent and
11 total service-connected disability.

12 (b) Beginning with the real property taxes levied in 2005, a disabled veteran
13 or the unmarried surviving spouse of a disabled veteran may claim a tax credit
14 against the property tax due on any of his or her real property, up to the total amount
15 of that tax, if the property is not used for pecuniary gain.

16 (c) A person may claim the credit under par. (b) by applying for the credit on
17 a form prescribed by the department of revenue. The person shall file the form with
18 the treasurer of the county in which the property related to the claim is located or,
19 if the property is located in a city that collects taxes under s. 74.87, with the treasurer
20 of the city in which the property related to the claim is located. Subject to review by
21 the department of revenue, a treasurer who receives a completed form under this
22 paragraph shall direct that the property described in the form be identified on the
23 tax roll as property for which the person is entitled to receive the credit under par.

24 (b) A claim made under this paragraph is valid for 5 years.
