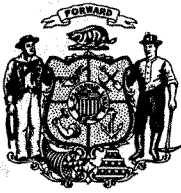

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under current law, the department is required to issue a resident fishing license, resident small game hunting license, or a resident deer hunting license to a member of the armed forces who is in active service with the U.S. armed forces and stationed in this state, regardless of the person's place of residence.

This bill requires the department to issue a resident deer hunting license, without the payment of any fee, to a member of the armed forces who is in active service with the U.S. armed forces, is not stationed in this state, and is on furlough or leave, regardless of the person's place of residence.

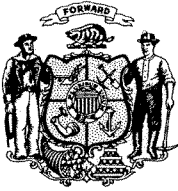
