Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

Bill Summary:

The bill creates a new resident deer hunting license, without the payment of any fee, to a member of the armed forces who is a resident of this state, serving on active duty in the U.S. armed forces, not stationed in this state, and on furlough or leave.

Fiscal Estimate:

A. One-Time Development Cost

There will be a one-time cost of \$1,000 to create the functional capacity of a new license on the Automated License Issuance System.

B. Projected Annual Revenue Loss

Although there will be minimal on-going operational costs to issue the new license, there will be a \$100,300 annual loss of revenue to the Fish and Wildlife Account as a result of the new license. Lost revenue includes both state and federal.

1. State license fees

In license year 2004, the state issued approximately 3,000 Armed Forces fishing/small game licenses. Assume that if an Armed Forces deer license is created, there will be 3,000 resident gun deer customers and 1,000 resident archery deer customers = 4,000 customers x \$18.50 (license fee minus issuance and transactions fees) = \$74,000 state license fee revenue lost.

TOTAL revenue lost is estimated to be \$100,265 per year.

*In license year 2004, the state issued approximately 3,000 Armed Forces Fishing/Small Game licenses.

2. Federal Pittman-Robertson reimbursement

The federal government does not provide federal match to any licenses issued free of charge. Assume 3,090 customers (3,000 unique gun hunters + 90 unique archery hunters) x \$8.50 Pittmen-Robertson reimbursement under the Federal Aid & Wildlife Restoration Act = \$26,265 federal revenue lost.

TOTAL estimated revenue lost per year = \$100,265, rounded to \$100,300.
