Rep. Gottlieb would like both an Assembly Sub and an Assembly (simple) amendment drafted to AB 483 as follows:

Amend 43.11 3(d) as follows:

(d) The plan of library services for a county may include minimum standards of operation for public libraries in the county. Minimum standards of operation may not include a minimum funding level. The county shall hold a public hearing on any standards proposed under this paragraph. The standards shall take effect if they are approved by the county and the public library boards of at least 50% of the participating municipalities in the county that contain, according to the most recent estimate prepared under s. 16.96, at least 80% of the population of participating municipalities in the county.

Repeal and recreate 43.18 (2m) as follows:

43.18 (2m) EXPULSION. With the approval of the division, a public library system may expel, or reduce aids or services to:

- (a) a municipality or county that fails to meet the requirements under s. 43.15 (2) or (4)
- (b) a municipality whose public library fails to meet the minimum standards of operation established under 43.11 (3) (d)

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

With certain exceptions, current law requires each county in a public library system to maintain its financial support for library services at a level that is not lower than the average of the previous three years. Similarly, a municipal, county, or joint public library participating in a public library system must receive funding from the municipality or county at a level that is not lower than the average of the previous three years. This bill eliminates these requirements.

For further information see the state and local fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.

SECTION 1. 43.15 (2) (a) of the statutes is renumbered 43.15 (2).
