Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

AB-503 would require the Group Insurance Board to offer health insurance coverage to domestic partners of University of Wisconsin System employees and annuitants. Assumptions used for the purposes of this estimate are as follows:

- * Both same sex and opposite sex domestic partners would be eligible for coverage.
- * Approximately 216 single individual contracts would be converted to family contracts.
- * Some existing UW System employees with family contracts would add a dependent as a result of this bill.
- * As a result of the increased number of covered lives, it is estimated that the total premium costs for the UW System will increase 2% or \$5.9 million annually (in calendar year 2005 dollars).
- * Department of Employee Trust Fund administrative costs associated with implementation are estimated to be \$72,300 SEG (IT system changes, printing, postage, training, manual and bulletin revisions). In addition, approximately 0.4 SEG FTE will be required during the implementation of the provisions of bill. No material on-going expenses are anticipated.
