Darin,

I don't know if you're the person who does EAB issues in the Bureau, but I started with you since it's attached to DVA. If it's not you, can you forward this on?

Assembly Bill 210 (the ch. 45 recodification bill) was concurred in by the Senate yesterday. That bill moves the EAB statutes out of ch. 45 and into ch. 39 (Ed. Agencies). However, AB 100 changes the EAB's attachment from DVA to the Tech. College System, and moves the EAB statutes into ch. 38 (Tech. Colleges). Pam Shannon, Bob Nelson and I will probably be working

on an amendment that reconciles the Budget with AB 210, assuming AB 210 is signed first. Our question is whether there were any feelings expressed by Joint Finance or by DOA about whether ch. 38 or 39 is the logical place for the EAB statutes. It's hard to imagine that they got to that level of detail, but we wanted to check. (Dave Dies from EAB called me a couple of weeks ago and he prefers ch. 39, but the Gov.'s budget bill put them in ch. 38.)

Pam/Bob (and I cc'ed Darin to keep him in the loop),

Anthony just called. He spoke with Ellen Nowak, who could only speak briefly since they were on the floor today. Ellen has been apprised of the dilemma, although not all of the details. She asked that the 3 attorneys prepare an amendment to the Budget and have it ready by Monday afternoon. It would be presented as a technical amendment. She has to talk with the Speaker to see how he wants to proceed.

Anthony also spoke with John Murphy in Sen. Schultz's office. John would prefer that the amendment be added in the Assembly.

We should get together soon and divvy this up. As I see it, we have to do the following:

¥1.

- 1. Fix any cross-references in ch. 20 to conform with AB 210.
- 2. Fix any cross-references in other provisions outside of ch. 45 that are affected by the Budget to conform with AB 210.



- 3. Do the EAB changes recommended by Gordon.
- 4. Fix the Budget provisions that affect ss. 45.25 and 45.396 (education) so that they fit into the AB 210 structure.
- 5. Fix the Budget provisions that affect ss. 45.351 (assistance) so that they fit into the AB 210 structure.
- 6. Fix the Budget provisions that relate to veterans housing (p. 449) so that they fit into the AB 210 structure.
- 7. Fix the remaining Budget provisions that relate to ch. 45 so that they fit into the AB 210 structure.

If Gordon is able to do number 3, maybe the rest of us can each take 2 items (one relatively hard and one relatively easy) and then get together tomorrow and compare notes.






