Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The bill includes certain provisions that are also in the biennial budget bill regarding the sale or contracting of operations of power plants at instutitions including those used by the Department of Veteran Affiars.

The Department is not aware of any analysis of whether the sale of the plants or the contracting is financially beneficial to the state. This would depend on many market factors. The cost of buying power back cannot be determined at this time so the sale or contracting of the plants may cost the state more or less than present.

Any local effects are unknown.
