1. If the local board (of any district that doesn't already have a collegiate transfer program) approves establishment of a collegiate transfer program in the district, the local board shall submit a request to the WTCS board stating the reasons for the request, including a statement of the unmet need for collegiate transfer offerings in the district.
2. The WTCS Board must forward every request under # 1. to the Board of Regents for its approval under 36.31(1). (This is regardless of whether WTCS board supports the local request. This is because at the hearing the Regents stated that WTCS board never asks for approval. WTCS board doesn't want to approve so they never ask the Regents to approve. Rob wants to force WTCS to ask for approval in every case and force Regents to issue a decision on every local board request.)
2. The WTCS and Regents must each hold at least 1 public hearing on the issue within 60 days of receiving the request from the local board. In lieu of each holding a hearing, they may hold a joint hearing.
3. The WTCS board and the Regents must each hold a vote the record within 90 days of receiving the request from the local board.
4. If either Board votes against allowing the requested establishment of a collegiate transfer program, that Board shall prepare a written report giving the reasons for its decision and recommendations for meeting the unmet need for collegiate transfer offerings in the district that are identified in the local board's request. This report must be completed within 30 days of the vote under #3.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law authorizes the Wisconsin Technical College System (WTCS) Board to designate and approve any collegiate transfer program offered by a technical college district. A collegiate transfer program is a full-time program in which the credits earned may be transferable to a four-year institution of higher education. A collegiate transfer program is currently available only at Madison Area Technical College, Milwaukee Area Technical College, and Nicolet Area Technical College.

This bill directs the WTCS Board to approve a liberal arts collegiate transfer program in any technical college district in which there is not located a University of Wisconsin two-year collegiate campus. The bill also exempts the approval of these programs from the prohibition on broadening the technical college system's collegiate transfer program offerings beyond those in existence in the 1972-73 academic year.
