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

3 "1. Before entering the land, the assessor notifies the land owner that the
4 assessor or the assessor's staff intends to enter the land in order to make an
5 assessment on behalf of the state or a political subdivision on or about a certain date,
6 unless the land owner contacts the assessor to reschedule the approximate date of
7 the assessment.

8 2. The land owner does not reschedule the approximate date of the
9 assessment."
