

Currently, the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) is required to charge certain fees for resident and nonresident camping at state parks, depending on the classification type of the campground. For example, the resident fee for camping one night at a type A campground is \$8, while a nonresident pays \$10. In addition, DNR has authority to charge an additional fee of \$1 for residents or up to \$1.75 for nonresidents, \$1 per pet at the campsite, and an \$1 more per night for camping on Friday, Saturday, or Sunday night. Current law also allows DNR to increase these rates where local market conditions justify higher camping fees. DNR may waive camping fees for certain classes of persons or charge special fees for certain groups or persons.

This bill allows DNR to charge an additional \$5 per night camping fee for persons who camp at Mirror Lake State Park. The money received from this additional fee must be used for a grant program to a nonprofit organization whose membership consists of at least one-half of the owners of lake front property on Mirror Lake. The grant must be used to protect and improve the water quality in Mirror Lake. The organization receiving a grant must provide 20 percent of the cost of the project.
