## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

This bill adds counties to the list of governmental units that may apply to become Main Street communities and requires Commerce to select Clark County as a Main Street community. This bill will have no fiscal effect on the Department of Commerce.

The bill will increase costs for local governments that compete and are chosen to participate in the program, and that pledge funds to run their local Main Street program. Those costs are entirely discretionary with the local government.
