#### **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

AB 807 will require regular meetings between the secretary of health planning and finance and the secretary of administration to "formulate decisions on issues concerning the health plan and DHPF and how the scope and functions of DHPF affect the scope and functions of" the Board on Aging and Long Term Care. While there does not appear to be a requirement to involve the executive and administrative staff of BOALTC in these meetings, it is reasonable to assume that the agency's input would be sought.

Aside from the time and research required to provide timely and accurate input into this process, there no significant requirement in AB 807 that would impact the agency's budget.

It is not possible for this agency to determine whether or not there will be any impact on local government costs as a result of passage of this bill.
