Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

2005 AB 833 would impact current statutory language regarding the sale, use, and possession of certain fireworks. Specifically, it would allow the sale of regulated fireworks to a nonresident person without a permit regardless of the person's location, for use outside this state. Currently, a nonresident individual must be physically located outside of the state. Previous to a recent court decision, however, a nonresident individual could buy fireworks regardless of their location. Also, the bill allows a fireworks user's permit to be issued to a single individual. Currently, such permits may only be issued to an entity or any group of individuals.

There would be no workload or fiscal impact for the Department associated with 2005 AB 833. The Department also estimates that there would be no workload or fiscal impact for local units of government.
