Sorry about the prior email, here is the language for the amendment:

Amendment Version #1  
441.01 Board of Nursing.

- (3) The board may establish minimum standards for schools of professional nurses and schools for licensed practical nurses, including all related clinical units and facilities and make and provide periodic survey and consultations to such schools. The board may require that faculty at schools for professional nurses and schools for licensed practical nurses hold a Master's degree, but may not require that more than 75 percent of the faculty hold a Master's or Doctorate degree in nursing. It may also establish rules to prevent unauthorized persons from practicing professional nursing. It shall approve all rules for administration of this chapter in accordance with ch. 227.
