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

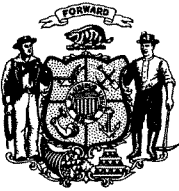

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Current law, as created by 2005 Wisconsin Act 25 (~~was/were~~ budget act), provides the remission ✓ of tuition for certain students attending the University of Wisconsin System and technical college campuses. Under that act, the spouses, children, or surviving spouses of certain veterans are eligible for a full remission of tuition at the University of Wisconsin System ✓ and at the technical colleges. For the spouse, surviving spouse, or child to be eligible, the veteran must have entered service while a resident ✓ of this state and either died while on duty or incurred a service-connected disability that is rated as 30 percent or more while a resident of this state.

This bill adds fee remission eligibility to spouses, surviving spouses, or children of veterans if the veteran is a resident of this state and was a resident of this state for at least 15 ✓ continuous years before the student registers.

For further information see the *state* fiscal estimate, which will be printed as an appendix to this bill.
