I have been talking with some folks out in DC about the Health Care IT stuff and how we can instill some accountability. There is a commission currently working on a certification process and that starting in May of this year will be certifying Healthcare IT systems as being ok to implement because they conform to the standards set by the American Health Information Community and other factors. The commission is the Certification Commission for Healthcare Information Technology. We have decided that it would be best to link the eligibility of the credits for any software to a certification by this commission. 
