## **Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate**

This bill creates the Super Employment and Economic Development Zone Grants program within the Department. Under this program, the Department may award grants to businesses that locate in areas designated as extremely depressed and create at least 100 qualifying jobs. Under the bill, at least 90 percent of the jobs created must pay a family-supporting wage, and the business must attempt to fill at least 75 percent of the positions with people who reside in the designated depressed area.

The Department is likely to be able to absorb this program given its current staffing allocation. Under this bill, the Department is required to promulgate administrative rules to define eligible costs, extremely depressed areas, family-supporting wages and qualifying jobs. In addition, the Department must designate extremely depressed areas in Wisconsin. The Department will be required to develop application forms and guidelines, research and designate extremely depressed areas, underwrite grants, perform required reporting activities, monitor grant recipients for compliance, provide assistance to potential recipients, answer questions and publicize the program.
