

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


Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

¶ The budget bill, 2005 Wisconsin Act 25, consolidated most state staff employed in the area of information technology server and network infrastructure into a central staff at the Department of Administration, including staff from the Department of Veterans Affairs.

¶ This bill reverses that consolidation for the Department of Veterans Affairs and authorizes 3.29 FTE positions in the department.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. Nonstatutory provisions.

(1) The authorized FTE positions for the department of veterans affairs, funded from the appropriation under s. 20.485 (1) (gk), are increased for fiscal year 2006-07 by 1.51 PR positions for the purpose of providing information technology server and network infrastructure staff.
