#### Assumptions Used in Arriving at Fiscal Estimate

The proposed bill would reverse the consolidation of information technology server and network infrastructure staff into a central staff at the Department of Administration as it affects the Department of Veterans Affairs. There would be a reduction of 3.29 FTE from the Department of Administration at a salary rate of \$68,000 per FTE and a fringe benefit rate of 38.19%.

There would be no other fiscal effect on the Department of Administration.

### **Long-Range Fiscal Implications**

There would be a permanent reduction of 3.29 FTE and related personnel services costs.
