

2005 ASSEMBLY BILL 1167

April 3, 2006 – Introduced by Representative PARISI. Referred to Committee on Ways and Means.

1 **AN ACT to create** 66.0145 of the statutes; **relating to:** authorizing a property
2 owner to have his or her name removed from a governmental Internet listing
3 of property taxes assessed.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

Under this bill, a taxation district (district) that imposes property taxes is required to remove the name of a property owner, upon the owner's request, from an Internet listing of property taxes assessed by the district. The bill also requires the taxation district to allow the property owner to remove his or her name from the Internet listing. Such an Internet listing may contain the property taxes assessed by the district for each parcel number or street address within the jurisdiction.

The bill also specifically authorizes a district to maintain records in its offices that contain the property taxes assessed by the district for each parcel number or street address within the jurisdiction, and these office records may also contain the name of the property owner.
