12	Hemauer, a native of Chilton, Wisconsin; and
13	Whereas, Private First Class Hemauer is survived by his parents, Andrew and
14	Anne Hemauer of Chilton and brothers, Brad and Lucas Hemauer; and

1	Whereas, Private First Class Hemauer was laid to rest on Thursday, June 2,
2	2005, at St. Mary's Catholic Church in Chilton; now, therefore, be it
3	Resolved by the assembly, the senate concurring, That the legislature of
4	the state of Wisconsin commemorates the remarkable life of Private First Class Kyle
5	M. Hemauer and extends its deepest sympathies to his family, friends, and
6	colleagues; and, be it further
