2005 ASSEMBLY RESOLUTION

1 **Relating to:** Black History Month and honoring Company F of the 29th USCT.

2 Whereas, February is Black History Month ^{which gives} giving all citizens an opportunity
3 to recognize and celebrate the contributions African-Americans have made to
4 Wisconsin, the United States, and the world; and

5 Whereas, during the Civil War a substitution system and a bounty system was ^{was}
6 established, allowing states to hire non-residents and substitutes to meet their draft ^{STET}
7 quotas for soldiers in the Union Army; and

8 Whereas, hundreds of African-Americans, including freemen and escaped
9 slaves, were hired as substitutes and took the place of Wisconsin residents in combat,
10 despite the fact that many of these African-Americans had never set foot in the state
11 of Wisconsin; and

12 Whereas, many of these African-American troops substituting for Wisconsin
13 residents served in Company F of ^{the 10th} 29th Infantry of U.S. Colored Troops, ^{9th} Ninth Army
14 Corps, ^{4th} Fourth Division, in ^{STET} the ^{2nd} Second Brigade in the Army of the Potomac; and

1 Whereas, the men of Company F of the 29th USCT served with distinction and
 2 valor on behalf of Wisconsin, seeing action in the Battle of the Crater, the Petersburg
 3 Campaign, the Bermuda Hundred Campaign, the Richmond Campaign, the
 4 Appomattox Campaign, and the Rio Grande Campaign; and

5 Whereas, after the Civil War a small number of the surviving members of the
 6 29th USCT returned without fanfare to live and work the remainder of their lives in
 7 Wisconsin; now therefore, be it

8 *Resolved by the assembly, That* as part of Black History Month, the members
 9 of the Wisconsin assembly salute the service of the men of Company F, 29th USCT,
 10 who placed themselves in harm's way in the cause of freedom; and, be it further

11 *Resolved, That* the members of the Wisconsin assembly honor the memory of
 12 those African-American troops who laid down their lives as substitutes for
 13 Wisconsin residents.
