2005 ASSEMBLY RESOLUTION

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To create assembly rule 98m; relating to: prohibitions on fund-raising social events and related campaign contributions by the assembly leaders and members of the assembly before the date of enactment of the executive budget bill.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This assembly rule is created to prohibit fund-raising social events and related compaign contributions by assembly leaders and members of the assembly before the date of enactment of the executive budget bill.

Resolved by the assembly, That:

SECTION 1. Assembly rule 98m is created to read:

ASSEMBLY RULE 98m. Campaign contributions before budget. (1) In this

8 rule:

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(a) "Contribution," "legislative campaign committee," and "personal campaign

committee" have the meanings given for the terms in section 11.01 of the statutes.

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(b) "Legislative leader" means a member of the assembly committee on organization or the assembly committee on finance.

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- (2) A legislative leader or member may not schedule, hold, or attend, or solicit, make, or receive, a contribution for or at; or authorize a legislative campaign committee to schedule, hold, or attend, or solicit, make, or receive, a contribution for or at; and a legislative leader or member may not schedule, hold, or attend, or solicit, make, or receive, a contribution for or at; or authorize his or her personal campaign committee to schedule, hold, or attend, or solicit, make, or receive, a contribution for or at; a fund–raising social event or otherwise after January 1 of the odd–numbered year and before the date of enactment, as defined in section 35.095 (1) (a) of the statutes, of the executive budget bill introduced under section 16.47 (1) of the statutes.
- (3) Subsection (2) does not apply to a fund-raising social event of a legislative campaign committee held during the period between the first day authorized for filing nomination papers for any special election to the assembly and the date of the special election.
- (4) Subsection (2) does not apply to a fund-raising social event of a current member of the assembly or his or her personal campaign committee held during the period between the first day authorized for filing nomination papers for any office for which a current member of the assembly is a candidate and the date of the election for that office, if the event is held within the boundaries of the jurisdiction or district served by the office for which the current member of the assembly is a candidate.
- (5) Subsection (2) does not apply to a fund-raising social event of a current member of the assembly or his or her personal campaign committee held during the period between the first day authorized for filing nomination papers for any office,

other than representative to the assembly, in the case of a member of the assembly,
for which a current member of the assembly is a candidate and the date of the election
for that other office.
