1 **To create** assembly rule 98m; relating to: prohibitions on fund-raising social
2 events and related campaign contributions by the assembly leaders and
3 members of the assembly before the date of enactment of the executive budget
4 bill.

Analysis by the Legislative Reference Bureau

This assembly rule is created to prohibit fund-raising social events and related campaign contributions by assembly leaders and members of the assembly before the date of enactment of the executive budget bill.

Resolved by the assembly, That:

6 SECTION 1. Assembly rule 98m is created to read:

7 ASSEMBLY RULE 98m. **Campaign contributions before budget.** (1) In this
8 rule:

9 (a) "Contribution," "legislative campaign committee," and "personal campaign
10 committee" have the meanings given for the terms in section 11.01 of the statutes.

1 (b) "Legislative leader" means a member of the assembly committee on
2 organization or the assembly committee on finance.

3 (2) A legislative leader or member may not schedule, hold, or attend, or solicit,
4 make, or receive, a contribution for or at; or authorize a legislative campaign
5 committee to schedule, hold, or attend, or solicit, make, or receive, a contribution for
6 or at; and a legislative leader or member may not schedule, hold, or attend, or solicit,
7 make, or receive, a contribution for or at; or authorize his or her personal campaign
8 committee to schedule, hold, or attend, or solicit, make, or receive, a contribution for
9 or at; a fund-raising social event or otherwise after January 1 of the odd-numbered
10 year and before the date of enactment, as defined in section 35.095 (1) (a) of the
11 statutes, of the executive budget bill introduced under section 16.47 (1) of the
12 statutes.

13 (3) Subsection (2) does not apply to a fund-raising social event of a legislative
14 campaign committee held during the period between the first day authorized for
15 filing nomination papers for any special election to the assembly and the date of the
16 special election.

17 (4) Subsection (2) does not apply to a fund-raising social event of a current
18 member of the assembly or his or her personal campaign committee held during the
19 period between the first day authorized for filing nomination papers for any office for
20 which a current member of the assembly is a candidate and the date of the election
21 for that office, if the event is held within the boundaries of the jurisdiction or district
22 served by the office for which the current member of the assembly is a candidate.

23 (5) Subsection (2) does not apply to a fund-raising social event of a current
24 member of the assembly or his or her personal campaign committee held during the
25 period between the first day authorized for filing nomination papers for any office,

1 other than representative to the assembly, in the case of a member of the assembly,
2 for which a current member of the assembly is a candidate and the date of the election
3 for that other office.
