ASSEMBLY RULE 11 (12) Meetings of committees end at midnight unless adjourned earlier. Committees may not meet or conduct business during the hours between midnight and 8 a.m. Assembly members of committees or other bodies may not be present at or participate in a meeting of or participate in the conduct of
