

2005 ASSEMBLY RESOLUTION 57

May 31, 2006 – Introduced by Representatives SHERIDAN and BENEDICT.

1 **Relating to:** honoring the life and public service of Lewis T. Mittness, Jr.

2 Whereas, Lewis T. Mittness, Jr., was born in La Crosse on July 29, 1929; and

3 Whereas, Mr. Mittness graduated from Tomah High School in 1945; and

4 Whereas, Mr. Mittness attended UW–La Crosse before serving in the Army of
5 the United States of America from 1951 to 1953; and

6 Whereas, after his service in Korea, Mr. Mittness completed a bachelor of
7 science degree in secondary education at UW–Stevens Point in 1954; and

8 Whereas, Mr. Mittness married his wife, Ruth Ann, in Stevens Point on June
9 12, 1954; and

10 Whereas, Mr. Mittness earned a master of education degree in school
11 administration from UW–Madison in 1959; and

12 Whereas, Mr. Mittness was deeply moved and called to public service by the
13 assassination of President John F. Kennedy; and

14 Whereas, Mr. Mittness was first elected to the Wisconsin assembly in 1964 and
15 served in the 1965 to 1975 sessions; and
