

## 2005 SENATE JOINT RESOLUTION 76

April 20, 2006 – Introduced by Senators RISSER, MILLER, ERPENBACH, ROESSLER, OLSEN, A. WILLIAMS, MURSAU, SHERIDAN, HEBL, CULLEN, JESKEWITZ, TRAVIS, MEYER, POPE-ROBERTS, TURNER, VRUWINK, HUBLER, DAVIS, MCCORMICK, BERCEAU, LEHMAN, KRAWCZYK, MOLEPSKE, BOYLE, PRIDEMORE, OTT, NASS, HUNDERTMARK and VAN AKKEREN. 1     **Relating to:** commending the University of Wisconsin women’s hockey team.

2             Whereas, the 2005–06 University of Wisconsin women’s hockey team won its  
3 first NCAA Division I Women’s Ice Hockey National Championship with a 3–0 win  
4 over 2–time defending champion and arch rival Minnesota on March 26, 2006; and

5             Whereas, the UW women’s hockey team completed its first championship  
6 season with a remarkable 36–4–1 record, winning both the WCHA regular season  
7 and playoff championships, and finishing the year on a 12–game winning streak; and

8             Whereas, the UW women’s hockey team was recognized with a number of team  
9 and individual achievements, including 5–all WCHA selections (including player of  
10 the year, defensive player of the year, and coach of the year), 10 all–WCHA academic  
11 selections, 2 named all–Americans, 3 NCAA all–tournament selections, including  
12 Jessie Vetter who was named the tournament’s most outstanding player and Sara  
13 Bauer, winner of the Patty Kazmaier Memorial Award, given to the most outstanding  
14 player in collegiate women’s hockey; and
