Relating to: requesting a summit on civic education and providing for the preparation of a report and recommendations to promote and enhance civic education in Wisconsin schools.

Whereas, civic education encourages young people to be thoughtful and productive members of their communities and future leaders of the state of Wisconsin; and

Whereas, it is essential to the future health of our representative democracy that all young people be knowledgeable about democratic principles and practices, engaged in their communities and in politics, and committed to the public good; and Whereas, on the National Assessment of Educational Progress in 1998, 75 percent of pupils scored at "basic" or "below basic" levels; and

Whereas, according to The Civic and Political Health of the Nation: A Generational Portrait, nearly one-half of 15- to 25-year-olds indicate that civic

education increases their interest and participation in civic affairs; and
