





MA Coverage for Youths Leaving Out-of-Home Care

Current Language

s. 49.46 (1) (a) 5. defines which groups are categorically eligible for Medical Assistance.

Proposed Change

Create a new paragraph under s. 49.46 (1) (a) so that youths are eligible for MA up to the age 21 (under 21 years of age) who on their 18th birthday are in foster care under the responsibility of the State.

This expansion of MA eligibility would be phased-in by age cohort. Beginning January, 2006, youths 19 or younger would be eligible. In January, 2007 youths 20 or younger would be eligible.

Effect of the Change

This language will expand MA eligibility to youths up to age 21, who were in foster care on their eighteen birthday, age-out of the foster care system and are not otherwise eligible for MA.

Rationale for the Change

Children and youths in out-of-home care have higher than average health care needs. These higher health care needs, which continue into adulthood, are unmet when youths leave out-of-home care and lose MA eligibility. These youths are less likely than youths of the same age group who were not placed in out-of-home care to have the income or savings to access needed health care. These youths are also unlikely to access health care coverage through family members.

The federal Chafee Foster Care Independence Act of 1999 (attached) provides federal matching funds to states who provide categorical MA coverage under Title IV-E to youths, up to a maximum age of 21, who have aged out of out-of-home care.


