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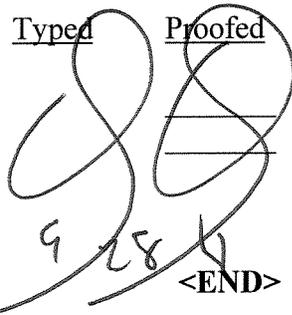

## DHFS TANF Allocations

### Current Language

Section 49.175(1)(ze) allocates TANF funds for various DHFS programs.

### Proposed Change

The Department requests that several allocations be revised to the levels indicated below:

s. 49.175(1)(ze)(1) *Kinship care and long term kinship care assistance*: \$23,748,400 per fiscal year in FY 06 and FY 07.

s. 49.175(1)(ze)(2) *Children of recipients of social security income*: \$30,526,200 in FY 06 and \$29,389,800 in FY 07.

s. 49.175(1)(ze)(10m) *Safety Services*: \$7,323,200 per fiscal year in FY 06 and FY 07

s. 49.175(1)(ze)(12) *Milwaukee and statewide child welfare administration*: \$1,310,800 in FY 06 and \$1,317,700 in FY 07.

### Effect of the Change

The new TANF allocation amounts reflect the Department's re-estimates of the Kinship Care, SSI, Caretaker Supplement, Bureau of Milwaukee Child Welfare, and WiSACWIS budgets for the 2005-2007 biennium.

In its 2005-2007 biennial budget request, the Department requests no change in current funding levels for the Bureau of Milwaukee Child Welfare Safety Services program. The above change to the Safety Services allocation corrects a technical error in the current statutory language.

**PUBLIC ASSISTANCE**

Under current law, DWD is required to allocate specific amounts of moneys in each fiscal year, including federal moneys received under the federal Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) block grant program, for various public assistance programs. This bill revises the amounts of moneys that DWD is required to allocate in each fiscal year for the following programs administered by DHFS: Kinship Care, the program that provides payments to custodial parents who receive supplemental security income, the program that provides services to ensure the safety of children remaining at home, and the Milwaukee and statewide child welfare information systems.
