Brief Description of Intent:

2003 Act 33 eliminated the Department of Employment Relations, which was headed by a secretary, and transferred its functions to the newly created Office of State Employment Relations, which is headed by a director.

Wis. Stat. § 20.916(8) contains an apparent drafting error that occurred when 2003 Act 33 revisions were made. This section retains a reference to "secretary" (of the Department of Employment Relations] in lieu of the current correct term, which should be "director" (of the Office of State Employment Relation").

(8) Uniform travel schedule amounts; allowances.

(a) The director of the office of state employment relations shall recommend to the joint committee on employment relations uniform travel schedule amounts for travel by state officers and employees whose compensation is established under s. 20.923 or 230.12. Such amounts shall include maximum permitted amounts for meal and lodging costs, other allowable travel expenses under sub. (9) (d), and portorage tips, except as authorized under s. 16.53 (12) (c). In lieu of the maximum permitted amounts for expenses under sub. (9) (b), (c), and (d), the ~~secretary~~ director may recommend to the committee a per diem amount and method of reimbursement for any or all expenses under sub. (9) (b), (c), and (d).

9 on the dates prescribed under sub. (8). Appointing authorities shall at such times
10 each year as specified by the ~~secretary~~ director file with the director and with the
11 secretary of administration a list of employees showing their then existing pay rates
12 and their proposed new pay rates.

STATE EMPLOYMENT

The bill corrects two references to the position of the former secretary of employment relations. This position was abolished in 2003 Wisconsin Act 33 and the duties of the position were assigned to the director of the Office of State Employment Relations.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

2 SECTION 1. 20.916 (8) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

3 20.916 (8) (a) The director of the office of state employment relations shall
4 recommend to the joint committee on employment relations uniform travel schedule
5 amounts for travel by state officers and employees whose compensation is
6 established under s. 20.923 or 230.12. Such amounts shall include maximum

1 permitted amounts for meal and lodging costs, other allowable travel expenses under
2 sub. (9) (d), and portorage tips, except as authorized under s. 16.53 (12) (c). In lieu
3 of the maximum permitted amounts for expenses under sub. (9) (b), (c), and (d), the
4 secretary director may recommend to the committee a per diem amount and method
5 of reimbursement for any or all expenses under sub. (9) (b), (c), and (d).

6 **SECTION 2.** 230.12 (7m) of the statutes is amended to read:

7 230.12 (7m) PAY ADJUSTMENT FILING REQUIREMENTS. Except as provided in the
8 rules of the director and in the compensation plan, pay increases shall be made only
9 on the dates prescribed under sub. (8). Appointing authorities shall at such times
10 each year as specified by the secretary director file with the director and with the
11 secretary of administration a list of employees showing their then existing pay rates
12 and their proposed new pay rates.
