Erin:

Regarding the draft on appropriation consolidation for DWS, it does what the department requested. However, given the drafter's note soliciting suggestions for the analysis (The analysis doesn't really indicate the effect of this change. Is there a plain language explanation of the effect that is evident from the statutory change?). We would offer the following:

The drafter is correct that the practical effect is not entirely evident from the changed language (it relates to the types of positions that would be authorized in the appropriation through associated file maintenance). Certain position authority traditionally associated with the "Workforce Development" program in DWD's appropriation structure would instead be authorized in this appropriation.

In response to the drafter's question about whether there is, for the LRB analysis, a better plain-language explanation of the effect. It may be clearer to change the characterization in the second sentence from "expands the appropriation's purpose and funding to the administration of all programs....", to state that it removes the current-law limitation in the use of the appropriation for operations purposes to those related to "economic support." Any use for aids or local assistance purposes would continue to be "relating to economic support." Specifically, the second sentence could be replaced with something like.....

"This bill removes the current limitation of the use of the appropriation for administrative purposes to those related to economic support programs."

This sound less expansive than referring to all programs for which the appropriation could theoretically be used, but not contemplated in the accompanying file maintenance.
