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

ISSUE/TOPIC:	Create a new appropriation funded by the Water Resources Account of the Conservation Fund to facilitate the Transfer of the Environmental Inventory and Monitoring Section from Integrated Science Services to Endangered Resources.
PROPOSED CHANGE:	Renumber s. 20.370 (3)(mv) to be s.20.370(1)(fg) (<i>fy</i>)
EXPLANATORY NOTE:	The Department is transferring an organizational unit from Program 3 (the Environmental Inventory & Monitoring Section of the Bureau of Integrated Science Services) to Program 1 (Land) in the Endangered Resources subprogram as part of a reorganization. The Section being transferred is funded in part with Conservation SEG from the Water Resources account. There is currently no appropriation that authorizes the Endangered Resources subprogram to utilize Water Resources account funding. Creating this appropriation would allow the transfer of the funding for the Environmental Inventory & Monitoring Section to the Endangered Resources subprogram.
DESIRED EFFECTIVE DATE:	The effective date of the 2005-07 biennial budget.
