I am requesting nonstatutory language be drafted for inclusion with the 2005-07 biennial budget bill.

The draft will transfer \$125,000 in each year from the Department of Financial Institution's appropriation account under s. 20.144(1)(h) *Gifts, grants, settlements and publications* to the general fund.

Under current law, DFI pays expenses related to services including photocopying and document production with moneys received as fees for such services. This bill lapses to the general fund from those moneys \$125,000 on June 30, 2006, and \$125,000 on June 30, 2007.

Because there may be constitutional or other legal problems with spending moneys in this appropriation for a purpose other than the purpose for which it was originally appropriated, I have included a provision that prohibits the secretary of administration from lapsing moneys if the lapse would violate a condition imposed by federal government on the expenditure of the moneys or if the lapse would violate state or federal law. Is this okay?
