The draft will change the benefits available to conservation patron license holders.

The new ruffed grouse and woodcock stamp and hook and line sturgeon tags (both outlined in a previous drafting request) will be included as privileges of adult patron licenses under ss. 29.235(2) and (2m).

The Natural Resources Magazine and parks and trails stickers will be eliminated as benefits to holders of junior conservation patron licenses issued to 12- to 17-year-olds.
