



Subject: Budget draft request relating to exemption from the recycling tipping fee

I am requesting statutory language be drafted for inclusion with the 2005-07 biennial budget bill.

The draft will exempt paper recyclers from the \$3 per ton recycling tipping fee for waste material included in material they acquire for recycling. The exemption should apply only to material acquired during the normal course of recycling operations. The business must demonstrate that the waste in question was not generated at or by the facility. Finally, the amount of waste exempted from the fee may not exceed 1/10 percent of the total annual waste produced at or by the facility.
