PUBLIC ASSISTANCE

Under current law, DWD allocates specific amounts of moneys in each fiscal year, including federal Child Care Development Funds (CCDF) and federal moneys received under the federal Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) block grant program, for various public assistance programs and for child care-related purposes, including transferring moneys to DHFS for its day care licensing operations. This bill increases and decreases those allocations. The bill also eliminates some of the allocations under current law, including one for a transfer to DPI for Head Start, one for grants to organizations that provide various types of domestic abuse services, one for a transfer to the Child Abuse and Neglect Prevention Board, and one for providing funding to the Wausau school district for English training for Southeast Asian children. With respect to child care-related funding allocations, the bill eliminates allocations for a child care scholarship and bonus program and for administration of DWD's office of child care but adds an allocation to pay for a share of the costs of a mail-order lending library and information center operated by DPI's division for libraries, technology, and community learning.

While eliminating an allocation of CCDF or TANF funds does not eliminate a program or service that has other funding, the bill eliminates an allocation for grants for developing early childhood centers for providing outreach and training for parents and training for child care providers and eliminates the program also.

Under current law, DWD allocates specific amounts of moneys in each fiscal year, including federal Child Care Development Funds (CCDF) and federal moneys received under the federal Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) block grant program, for various public assistance programs and for child care-related purposes, including transferring moneys to DHFS for its day care licensing operations. This bill increases and decreases those allocations. The bill eliminates some of the allocations under current law, including one for a transfer to DPI for Head Start, one for grants to organizations that provide various types of domestic abuse services, one for a transfer to the Child Abuse and Neglect Prevention Board, and one for providing funding to the Wausau school district for English training for Southeast Asian children, and adds an allocation to pay for a share of the costs of a mail-order lending library and information center operated by DPI's division for libraries, technology, and community learning.

While eliminating an allocation of CCDF or TANF funds does not eliminate a program or service that has other funding, the bill eliminates an allocation for grants for developing early childhood centers for providing outreach and training for parents and training for child care providers and eliminates the program also plus A

Pam, this draft looks great. However, I realized I gave you an erroneous instruction:

Section 11 of the draft: I asked you to change the language under s. 49.137 (4m) from "the department shall award grants" to "the department may award grants". That was an error. Please undo that change (retain the "shall" language). Sorry about that.

Other than that, all the changes are consistent with what I was expecting.

Regarding the analysis section:

1) The first paragraph alludes to the elimination of certain allocations under s.49.175, even that doesn't happen in this draft. The repeal of those allocations are actually part of LRB drafts 1534, 1625 and 1635. Although it is correct to say that "the bill" eliminates those allocations.

2) One of the allocations that is eliminated under draft 1635 wasn't mentioned in your analysis. It is the allocation under s. 49.175 (1)(ze)7., Brighter futures and tribal adolescent services.

PUBLIC ASSISTANCE

Under current law, DWD allocates specific amounts of moneys in each fiscal year, including federal Child Care Development Funds (CCDF) and federal moneys received under the federal Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) block grant program, for various public assistance programs and for child care-related purposes, including transferring moneys to DHFS for its day care licensing operations. This bill increases and decreases those allocations. The bill eliminates some of the allocations under current law, including one for a transfer to DPI for Head Start, one for grants to organizations that provide various types of domestic abuse services, one for a transfer to the Child Abuse and Neglect Prevention Board, and one for providing funding to the Wausau school district for English training for Southeast Asian children, and adds an allocation to pay for a share of the costs of a mail-order lending library and information center operated by DPI's division for libraries, technology, and community learning.

While eliminating an allocation of CCDF or TANF funds does not eliminate a program or service that has other funding, the bill eliminates an allocation for grants for developing early childhood centers for providing outreach and training for parents and training for child care providers, and eliminates the program. The bill also permits DWD to award grants for the start-up or expansion of child care services

and to award grants to local governments and tribal governing bodies for programs to improve the quality of child care. Under current law, DWD is required to award these grants.
