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

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

Statutory Language Request

Title- Adult Literacy Grants

1. Create a new annual GPR appropriation (\$240,000) in DPI's Program 3, entitled Adult Literacy Grants.
2. From the appropriation, the state superintendent shall award grants to any nonprofit organization, as defined under s. 108.02 (19), for support of programs to train community-based adult literacy staff and to establish new volunteer-based programs in areas of the state that have demonstrated a need for adult literacy services.
3. Individual grants shall not exceed \$60,000 annually and no organization may receive more than one grant per fiscal year.
4. The state superintendent shall promulgate rules for the operation of the program.
